"Guide of good practices for the exploration and estimation of resources and reserves of Drag Materials" With the purpose of offering a tool that guides mining professionals and owners of the drag materials sector, the National Mining Agency (NMA) issued the 'Guide to Good Practices for the Exploration and Estimation of Drag Materials Resources and Reserves', an instrument for them to carry out more organized operations, aimed at minimizing the uncertainty and negative impacts that their operations could cause. The Guide reflects the government's commitment to manage energy mining development with the highest standards of environmental and social responsibility, including small and medium-sized mining in the country. The implementation of good practices allows to understand the value of the data that is generated during mining operations and contributes to reducing uncertainty inherent in alluvial deposits. This allows optimize the useful life of reservoirs and achieve sustainable exploitation, at social, environmental and economic levels, from mineral reserves. Resolution 263 of 25 May 2021 In order to generate strategies that promote mining with social responsibility, the National Mining Agency (NMA) has incorporated the Social Management Plan-SMP as one of the necessary instruments for mining owners to start the exploitation stage and thus guarantee a significant contribution to the community and area of influence of the mining project. It has been done through Resolution 263 of 25 May 2021, which modifies resolution 318 of June 20, 2018. The SMP seeks that the mining concessionaire designs and implements programs that prevent, mitigate and address the social risks generated in the area of influence by the development of the mining project. If mining is small-scale, the plan should be aimed at preventing and mitigating social risks, but if it is medium and large-scale mining, it should also generate opportunities and benefits to the community. Through the Social Management Plan, it is sought to guarantee the recognition and inclusion of all through compliance with the guidelines of the Public Policy on Human Rights and guidelines on a gender perspective. Likewise, it is intended to promote, maintain and retain positive relationships between local entities, communities and people linked to the development of the mining project.
