Prepare technical documents for Colombia's participation in international organizations governing investment and trade in services, such as UNCITRAL, WTO, OECD, and CAN, among others.2. Support the coordination of various OECD Committees involving entities from the Trade, Industry, and Tourism Sector.3. Compile bi-monthly reports on the outcomes of participations in different Committees.4. The NCP has an Advisory Committee, a quadripartite body established by the Ministry of Trade, Industry, and Tourism in compliance with Decree 1400, as outlined in Resolution 3879 of 2013. Its main function is to advise the NCP in its duties. The committee comprises a representative from the business sector, one from labor unions, one from Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs), and one from academia. This structure enables the NCP to maintain direct and ongoing contact with these stakeholder groups, fostering collaboration toward the implementation of the Guidelines.
